ORDER:

In the Government Order first read above, among other things, four posts of Therapeutic Assistants have been sanctioned on consolidated pay for starting of Yoga and Naturopathy wing at Arignar Anna Government Hospital of Indian Medicine, Chennai. In the Government Order second read above, the Government have accorded sanction to bring these posts into regular time scale of pay. In the Government Order third read above, adhoc rules for the post of Therapeutic Assistant in Indian Medicine and Homeopathy Department was framed. In the Government order fourth read above the Government accorded permission to conduct 2½ years Diploma in Nursing Therapy course. Subsequently in the Government Order fifth read above, Government have issued orders sanctioning 98 posts of Therapeutic Assistants to Yoga and Naturopathy Life Style Clinics in 18 Government Medical Colleges and 31 Government Headquarters Hospital. The Additional Chief Secretary / Commissioner of Indian Medicine and Homoeopathy has sent proposal for issuing amendment to the adhoc rules issued in the Government order 3rd read above. As the candidates possessing the certificate in Diploma in Nursing Therapy course

will be more suitable to hold the post of Therapeutic Assistant, the Government issue the following amendment to the adhoc rules for the post of Therapeutic Assistant.

The following notification will be published in the Tamil Nadu Government Gazette:-

NOTIFICATION.

In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to Article 309 of the Constitution of India, the Governor of Tamil Nadu hereby makes the following amendments to the Adhoc rules published with the Health and Family Welfare Department Notification No.(SRO)B-45/2008 at page 142 of part III – (Section)1 (b) of the Tamil Nadu Government Gazette, dated the 15th October 2008.

2. The amendments hereby made shall come into force on the date of publication of this Notification in the Tamil Nadu Government Gazette.

AMENDMENTS.

In the said rules, -

(1) for rule 3, the following shall be substituted, namely:-

“3) Appointment. - Appointment to the post shall be made by direct recruitment.”

(2) for rule 4, the following shall be substituted, namely:-

“4) Appointing authority. - The appointing authority for the post shall be the Commissioner of Indian Medicine and Homoeopathy, Chennai.”

(3). in rule 5, in sub-rule (b), for the expression “ the Minimum General Educational Qualification”, the expression “a Diploma in Nursing Therapy” shall be substituted.

(4) rule 6 shall be Omitted.
