ORDER:

In the Government Order second read above, Government accorded permission to the Director of Indian Medicine and Homoeopathy to start Diploma in Pharmacy course in Siddha at Government Siddha Medical College, Palayamkottai and Arignar Anna Government Hospital of Indian Medicine, Chennai and Diploma in Pharmacy course in Ayurveda and Unani at Arignar Anna Government Hospital of Indian Medicine, Chennai.

2. In the Government order fourth read above, Government have issued orders permitting the Special Commissioner of Indian Medicine and Homeopathy, Chennai for starting of 2½ years Diploma in Integrated Pharmacy (DIP) course in the Indian System of Medicine (ISM) at Arginar Anna Government Hospital of Indian Medicine and Homoeopathy, Chennai and the Government Siddha Medical College at Palayamkottai, Tirunelveli District. Therefore it is imperative to include the qualification of Diploma in Pharmacy courses in Siddha, Ayurveda and Unani and the Diploma in Integrated Pharmacy in the Indian System of Medicine in the special rules for the post of Pharmacist – Indigenous Medicine as the Diploma in Integrated Pharmacy course comprises of the Systems of Siddha, Ayurveda, Unani and Homoeopathy.

3. The following Notification will be published in the <u>Tamil Nadu Government</u> Gazette:-

NOTIFICATION.

In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to Article 309 of the Constitution of India, the Governor of Tamil Nadu hereby makes the following amendment to the Special Rules for the Tamil Nadu Medical Subordinate Service.

AMENDMENT.

In the said special rules, in Part-II, under the heading Branch II – Indigenous Medicine, in the annexure, for the entry 'Diploma in Indian System of Medicine' in column 1, against the entry 'category 6 Pharmacist, Indigenous Medicine' in Column 1, the following entries shall be substituted, namely -

"(1) Diploma in Indian System of Medicine; or

(2) Diploma in Pharmacy in Siddha / Ayurveda / Unani (Separately for each system); or

(3) Diploma in Integrated Pharmacy (DIP) conducted by the Government of

Tamil Nadu."
