ORDER:

The Government of India have enacted the Food Safety and Standards Act, 2006 (Central Act 34 of 2006) by repealing the Prevention of Food Adulteration Act, 1954. The said Central Act 34 of 2006 has come into force throughout the Country from 5th August 2011. In the Government Order 1st read above, the Government of Tamil Nadu has formed a new department called, "Tamil Nadu Food Safety and Drug Administration" to implement the Food Safety and Standards Act in the State. In the said Government Order, the existing posts sanctioned under the erstwhile Prevention of Food Adulteration Act under the control of Director of Public Health and Preventive Medicine has been transferred to the new department. Also certain number of existing posts and new posts are sanctioned. In the Government Order 2nd read above, the six Food Analysis Laboratories along with posts sanctioned and incumbents have been transferred from Director of Public Health and Preventive Medicine to the new Department.

2. In order to govern the service conditions of the incumbents discharging duties in the Tamil Nadu Food Safety and Drugs Administration Department, rules appended to this order are framed and published in the Tamil Nadu Government Gazette.

APPENDIX.

NOTIFICATION.

In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to Article 309 of the Constitution of India, the Governor of Tamil Nadu hereby makes the following Special Rules for the Tamil Nadu Food Safety Subordinate Service, which shall form part as Section 61 in volume III of the Tamil Nadu Services Manual.

RULES.

1. These rules may be called as the Special Rules for the Tamil Nadu Food Safety Subordinate Service.

2. The rules hereby made shall be deemed to have come into force with effect from 22nd December 2011.

2. Constitution.- The service shall consist of the following posts, which are classified as Technical namely:-

- ~~(1)~~ Junior Analyst
- ~~(2)~~ Laboratory Technician, Grade-I
- ~~(3)~~ Laboratory Technician, Grade-II
- ~~(4)~~ Electrician

3. **Appointment.-** Appointment to the posts specified in column (1) of the Table below shall be made by the methods specified in the corresponding entries in column (2) thereof:-

THE TABLE.

| <u>Posts</u> (1) | <u>Method of Appointment.</u> (2) |

| (1) <u>Junior Analyst</u> | (i) <u>By direct recruitment; or</u> (ii) <u>by promotion from the post of Laboratory Technician, Grade - I;</u> Provided that appointment by direct recruitment and by promotion shall be made in the ratio of <u>4:1</u> |
| (2) <u>Laboratory Technician, Grade-I</u> | by promotion from the post of <u>Laboratory Technician, Grade - II</u> |
| (3) <u>Laboratory Technician, Grade-II</u> | by direct recruitment. |
| (4) <u>Electrician</u> | by direct recruitment. |

4. **Appointing Authority.**- The appointing authority for the posts specified in column (1) of the Table below shall be the authorities specified in the corresponding entries in column (2) thereof:-

5. **Qualifications.**- (a). **Age** No person shall be eligible for appointment to the posts specified in column (1) of the Table below by direct recruitment, if he has completed or will complete the age specified in the corresponding entries in column (2) thereof on the first day of July of the year in which the selection for appointment is made.

(b). **Other Qualifications.**- No person shall be eligible for appointment to the posts specified in column (1) of the Table below by the methods specified in the corresponding entries in column (2) thereof, unless he possess the qualifications specified in the corresponding entries in column (3) thereof:-

6. Reservation of Appointment.- The Rule relating to reservation of appointments (General Rule 22) shall apply for appointment to the posts by direct recruitment.

7. Probation.- Every person appointed to the posts by direct recruitment shall, from the date on which he joins duty, be on probation for a total period of two years on duty within a continuous period of three years.

8. Test.- Every person appointed to the post of Junior Analyst shall pass the Account test for Subordinate Officers, Parts I and II within the period of his probation.

9. Preparation of annual list of approved candidates and crucial date.- For the purpose of preparation of annual list of approved candidates for appointment to the posts by direct recruitment or by promotion, on which the candidate should be qualified shall be the 15th February of every year.

10. Pay.- There shall be paid to the holders of the following posts, a monthly pay calculated in the Pay Band and Grade Pay indicated below:-

| (4) | Electrician | Rs.5200-20200+GP 2400 |

Provided that on and from the 1st October 2017, they shall be paid as per the Tamil Nadu Revised Scales of Pay Rules, 2017 in the level, in the pay matrix indicated below:-
