Establishment – Recruitment to the post of Lab Technician Grade III by the Medical Services Recruitment Board - Incentive marks for their temporary service rendered during COVID-19 Pandemic - Granted - Orders – Issued.

ORDER:-

The Hon'ble Supreme Court of India, in its judgement dated 30.04.2021 in Suo moto Writ Petition (Civil) No.3 of 2021 among others has directed to consider the services of candidates who have completed a minimum of 100 days of COVID-19 related duties. Based on the above lines, the Government of India in the Circular to State Governments / UTIs vide Notification No.20015/43/2021-Me-1 (FTS-8108321) Ministry of Health and Family Welfare, dated 03.05.2021 have recommended to consider giving preference in regular appointments, for those who complete a minimum of 100 days of COVID-19 related duty".

- 2. In G.O.(Ms) No.278, Health and Family Welfare (B1) Department, dated 17.08.2023, orders have been issued awarding incentive marks to the Medical Officers who have worked in the Government Medical Institutions during the COVID-19 Pandemic, based on their service during pandemic period, subject to certain conditions.
- 3. The Director of Public Health and Preventive Medicine taking into consideration of the guidelines of Government of India / orders of the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India has stated that orders have to be issued giving incentive marks to Lab Technician Grade III who have rendered services during COVID 19 as follows:-

SI. No.	Criteria	Marks to be given	
1.	For those who have worked in Government institutions during COVID19 pandemic for a period of minimum of six months to one year continuously (6 to 12 months) (without break in service)	Two marks	
2.	For those who have worked in Government institutions during COVID 19 pandemic for a period of over one year to one and half year continuously (12+months to 18 months) (without break in service)	Three marks	

3.	For those who have worked in Government institutions during COVID19 pandemic for a period of over one and half year to two years continuously (18+months to 24 months) (without break in service)	Four marks
4.	For those who have worked in Government Institutions during COVID 19 pandemic for a period of over two years continuously (over 24 months) (without break in service)	Five marks

- 4. The Director of Public Health and Preventive Medicine has further stated that the above marks may be awarded to the individuals concerned as a One Time measure only subject to the following conditions:
 - i. The individuals should have worked in Urban/Rural/ Local Body run Covid care centre / Covid Health Care Centre etc., / Medical Colleges/ Government institutions (Hospital, Primary Health Centre / Health Sub Centre).
 - ii. The individuals should obtain experience certificate/ duty certificate in the format annexed to this order from the following authorities as detailed below:-

- iii. This incentive marks are not eligible to the candidates for successive recruitments.
- 5. The Director of Public Health and Preventive Medicine has stated that the Medical Services Recruitment Board has to publish notification by indicating the system of awarding incentive marks for those who have worked during COVID-19 pandemic period. Further the incentive marks has to be confirmed and counted as and when the individuals appear for certificate verification along with the COVID-19 duty certificates. The Medical Services Recruitment Board has to suitably take note of the incentive marks while arriving at the list of successful candidates in the recruitment process conducted by Medical Services Recruitment Board, before releasing the results.

6. The Government after careful examination do and hereby accept the request of the Director of Public Health and Preventive Medicine to award incentive marks to Lab Technician Grade III candidates who were engaged during COVID-19, subject to the conditions listed in para 3 and 4 above as a onetime measure and also to instruct the Medical Services Recruitment Board as mentioned in para 5 above.
