

## MEDICAL SERVICES RECRUITMENT BOARD (MRB)

### **X. INSTRUCTIONS TO CANDIDATES APPEARING FOR OBJECTIVE TYPE EXAMINATION**

#### **Points to be borne in mind:-**

- i) Remember to take the Hall Ticket with a photo ID to the Examination Hall without fail.
- ii) **Candidates without Hall Ticket will not be admitted for the Exam on any account.**
- iii) You will be provided with a blue ball point pen at the exam hall and you shall shade the OMR answer sheet ONLY with that pen. Answer sheets shaded using any other material will attract invalidation.

#### **Detailed Instructions:**

- 1) Candidates are advised to download and print the Hall Ticket from [www.mrbexam.in](http://www.mrbexam.in). Please paste a recent passport size colour photograph on the appropriate box and bring the Hall Ticket to the examination hall. Please note that candidate shall sign in the box provided in the Hall Ticket, only in front of the invigilator at the examination hall.
- 2) Candidates who have sent more than one online application and consequently are in receipt of more than one Hall Ticket with different Examination Number should retain only one hall ticket and return the remaining Hall Ticket to the Board specifying the facts. Failing to do so will attract invalidation and disqualification.
- 3) The candidate should familiarize themselves about the location of the examination centre and appear for the examination only at the allotted examination centre mentioned in the Hall Ticket. Requests for the change of exam centre will not be entertained.
- 4) Candidates are advised to bring a photo identity card issued by a government agency. In case of doubt, the photo identity card of the candidate will be verified.

- 5) Candidates are strictly prohibited from bringing any pen, pencil, book, notes, dictionary, scale or drawing instruments side rule, calculators, cellular phone, pager, scrap or rough paper or bags of any kind, suitcases, any electrical/electronic / mechanical devices with communication facility etc. to the examination hall.
- 6) Candidates shall not bring any valuables, mobile, electronic devices etc. They shall leave all their personal belongings such as books, covers, mobile phones, handbags, etc, outside the examination centre. Tea/ Coffee, snacks, soft drinks etc. will not be served inside or outside the examination hall. Each candidate will be given a water bottle inside the hall. Candidates are prohibited from talking to each other. The examination will be video recorded
- 7) The objective type questions based examination will be for two and half hours from 10:00 am till 12:30 pm. Candidates will have to answer 200 objective type questions during the two and half hours.
- 8) The candidate should reach the examination venue at least one hour before the specified time and take his/her seat in the examination hall at least 30 minutes before the time prescribed for the commencement of the Exam, for receiving detailed instructions from the invigilator and completion of formalities.
- 9) No candidate will be allowed to enter the examination hall after 30 minutes of the start of the examination (after 10:30 am). Candidates will on no account be allowed to exceed the time allotted for answering the paper.
- 10) No candidate will be allowed to leave the examination hall before the end of the examination time (12:30 pm), on any account.
- 11) Candidates suffering from any communicable disease will not be admitted into the examination hall. Smoking is prohibited in the examination hall/ examination centre. Strict, silence and discipline should be maintained in the examination hall.

- 12) Candidates should show the Hall Ticket to the Invigilator/Chief Invigilator/Inspecting authorities of the examination hall, on demand, for verification.
- 13) Candidates shall always sit only in the seat allotted to them as per their Examination Number. Candidates cannot borrow any material / instruments from other candidates. Candidates may note that indiscipline or illegal practices like consulting other candidates, copying, carrying notes, using electronic/electrical / mechanical devices etc., is strictly prohibited. Any violation would lead to disqualification, dismissal from the exam hall and debarment from the present and future examinations.
- 14) The question booklet cover containing question booklets will be opened by the invigilator in the examination hall.
- 15) The candidates will be supplied with the question booklet containing OMR answer sheet by the invigilator, duly obtaining acknowledgement from the candidates therefor in the attendance sheet.
- 16) Read the instructions available on the first page of the question booklet supplied carefully. Doubts regarding the questions will NOT be entertained by the Invigilator.
- 17) Candidates are not allowed to open the question booklet until the invigilator asks them to do so. Any violation of this may attract disqualification. Candidates are NOT allowed to make markings of any kind in the question booklet, and NO rough work should be done in it.
- 18) Generally there will be four suggested answers for each question, marked as A, B, C and D. Only one of the four will be the most suitable and correct answer. After choosing the correct answer, shade the box completely with the blue ball point pen supplied in the examination hall. Do not shade more than one box. Once a choice of answer is shaded (A or B or C or D) it can't be erased and changed. **Candidate shall mark only one answer for a question, by shading ONLY one answer. If there is more than one marking for any question (even partially), no mark will be awarded for that question. Incorrect answers and invalid shading will not attract any mark.**
- 19) The Examination Number as shown in the Hall Ticket, will be pre-printed in the OMR answer sheet supplied to the candidates. Candidate should

verify his / her and Examination Number pre-printed in the OMR answer sheet properly and then write the Question booklet serial no. and Question booklet code etc. He/ She shall write his/her name in block letters and put his/her signature. If the OMR Answer Sheet is defective in any way, ask the Invigilator to replace it.

- 20) The OMR answer sheet will be invalidated if the box for question booklet serial number is not shaded, and could not be identified even by physical verification of the answer sheet.
- 21) The OMR Answer Sheet will be scanned using optical scanners. Keep your OMR answer sheet free from dust and damage. If any marking or writing other than shading on the OMR sheet is done, it may entail invalidation.
- 22) The candidate shall handover the Hall Ticket (along with OMR answer sheet and question booklet) to the invigilator at the end of the examination.
- 23) Requests from candidates for furnishing the causes of their failure in the test or for revaluation of their answer sheets will not be complied with.
- 24) Candidates are admitted to the examination based on their statements in their on-line application in regard to age, educational qualifications, community, registration details of professional council etc. and that the admission of the candidates is purely provisional subject to thorough scrutiny of the particulars and verification of their original documents later, on the days specified by MRB. If for one or more reasons, the candidate is found not qualified/ineligible his/her application will be summarily rejected and provisional selection if any made, will also be cancelled.
